## The Glenn A. and Melinda W. Adams National Eagle Scout Service Project of the Year Award

### Important Nomination Information

It is critical to include in each candidate's *Eagle Project Summary* the *various types and amount of leadership* exhibited by the Scout commencing with the initial stages of planning and as thereafter performed throughout the course of the service project until completion. Typically, the summarized information should include: *the basis for undertaking the project; the number of leadership hours contributed by the Scout; the quantity of personnel supporting the project; the total sum of service project team man hours rendered; the magnitude of work involved; the type of materials utilized; an indication of the amount of money raised; and the resulting impact to the beneficiary and the overall community as a result of the service project.*

**The *Eagle Project Summary* shall not exceed one single-spaced typed page.**
