

## The Glenn A. and Melinda W. Adams National Eagle Scout Service Project of the Year Award

## **Important Nomination Information**

It is critical to include in each candidate's Eagle Project Summary the various types and amount of leadership exhibited by the Scout commencing with the initial stages of planning and as thereafter performed throughout the course of the service project until completion. Typically, the summarized information should include: the basis for undertaking the project; the number of leadership hours contributed by the Scout; the quantity of personnel supporting the project; the total sum of service project team man hours rendered; the magnitude of work involved; the type of materials utilized; an indication of the amount of money raised; and the resulting impact to the beneficiary and the overall community as a result of the service project.

The Eagle Project Summary shall not exceed one single-spaced typed page.
