This month's highlights include: Citizenship in the World Merit Badge



The Citizenship in the World Merit Badge seeks to introduce and have Scouts understand the role of citizenship throughout the world and to develop their interest in the different elements and aspects of being a good world citizen. This is accomplished by the completion of several different but complementary tasks. There are seven distinct elements with unique applications to the various components of international citizenship. These seven areas are: Explaining good citizenship in the world and its meaning to the individual; Explaining the process and procedure to become a United States citizen and comparing the common and disparate elements with two other countries; Examining an arising world event and then discuss how a nation's national interest and relations with other countries are impacted and the effects made to the economy, national security and geographical conditions; Examining the function of: international law as opposed to domestic laws; or, a nation's economic climate and trade practices; to study and describe the roles of two international organizations; Research and describe the differences between constitutional and non-constitutional governments and how foreign relations are conducted as a result; and to undertake two specific tasks related to international scouting of a Scout's choice. This merit badge is a mandatory requirement to be attained for the rank of Eagle Scout.
