Who pays for Scouting?

The Daniel Webster Council is supported by financial investments from individuals, businesses, Scouting families and volunteers. As well as through camping and activity fees, the Popcorn Fundraiser, Trust Fund support, Special Events and other revenue sources. The Friends of Scouting annual giving campaign makes up more than 11% of the council's budget.

This meeting is ideally held sometime in January, February or March and in order to provide as little disruption as possible to the meeting the presenter will ask to be first on your agenda after the opening ceremony and will take no more than 7 minutes of your valuable meeting time. To ensure that your unit's presentation nets the best results it is always helpful if the unit leader and/or unit coordinator make the first contribution immediately following the presentation.
