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## Overview

### Merit Badge Workshops

The Merit Badge Workshop is a program initiative of the DWC Executive Board and our leadership team. Our goal with this program is two-fold:

1. Provide MB opportunities for Scouts that do not have easy access to Counselors or are restricted in some way due to geography, lack of adult volunteers, or availability of free time. For many of our Scouts, this program provides a similar opportunity to that of a Summer Camp Merit badge.
  - a. It should be noted that our badges in both programs are the same number of classroom hours and in some cases longer than our Summer Camp MB program.
2. Our second goal with this program is to expose Scouts to badges not often offered in conventional MB settings. Badges like Medicine taught by an RN or medical student or Engineering are not often offered in other settings and are unrepresented by our Council MB registered Counselors.

This program, like all of our Council programs, seeks to offer the Scouts of NH new program opportunities that will enhance their Scouting career and engage them in a long-term commitment to the program through challenging or new activities.

### Merit Badge Workshop Pro Series

This variation of the traditional workshop deals with businesses around the state that wish to offer their professional expertise in certain areas of their work. This series is great for those scouts that wish to broaden their horizons when it comes to careers.

### Merit Badge Workshop University

This extension to the traditional workshop takes the standard one-day format and follows a summer camp ideology. This format allows for more time-consuming merit badges to be offered allowing scouts to develop the necessary skills to complete requirements. This is traditionally a multi-day event at a more spacious venue such as Camp Carpenter.

### Adult Leader Training

This is a new and integrated program that focuses on training adults within the organization, and in helping units across Daniel Webster Council. By teaming up with one of our multiyear staff members from Griswold Scout Reservation, we have developed a program to give adequate training in a timely fashion without losing valuable time. While your Scout is enjoying one of the many Merit Badge Workshops, adults can also get training to better your unit, learn something new, and expand their scouting knowledge to benefit other units across the state! The opportunities are endless!
