Item #	Requirement	Qualified on 12/31/20?
1	Journey to Excellence – The unit must establish goals for the year and qualify for the Journey to Excellence Award (at least Silver level) by the end of the year.	
2	Friends of Scouting Presentation – The unit must schedule and conduct a presentation prior to June 30 and achieve its goal determined in partnership with the District Key 3.	
3	Participate in an Annual Council Product Sale – The unit will set a sales goal (agreed to by your District Key 3) and participate in any of the Council sponsored fundraisers, e.g. Adventure Cards Trail's End Popcorn or any other product sale offered during the scouting year.	
4	<p>New Family Engagement: In order for Scouting in NH to succeed it requires year-round recruitment by all units. Active promotion of Scouting fun is best exhibited by submitting pictures and stories to your local newspaper. (Each local newspaper may have their own submittal requirements and it is suggested you check with them for what may be required.) We encourage all units to submit at least one picture/article to your local newspaper showing Scouting fun in NH today per season (not a requirement, but a good practice).</p> <p>Cub Scout Packs: The Pack will host 2 Join Scouting Activities between August 1, 2020 and November 15, 2020. A "Join Scouting Activity" should be open to all eligible youth per the BSA's vision and in agreement with the Chartering Organization.</p> <p>Scouts BSA Troops: The Troop will host at least two "Join Scouting Activity" between September 1, 2020 and November 15, 2020 and encourage current members to "Bring a Buddy" to participate in an activity. A "Join Scouting Activity" should be open to all eligible youth per the BSA's vision and in agreement with the Chartering Organization.</p> <p>Spring - The Troop will host Webelos for an "Intro to Scouting" activity and conduct/participate in a AOL/Webelos-To-Scout ceremony.</p>

	<p>Growth in a Pack or Troop from your 2019 re-charter as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A unit with less than 10 youth must grow by 1 • A unit with membership between 10 and 20 must grow by 2 • A unit greater than 20 youth must grow by 10% <p>Crews:</p> <p>Crews are encouraged to form partnerships with local Troops and review list of older Scouts who are looking for more adventure with youth in their age. This is not designed to take away from the Troop, but act as a partnership with dual membership to encourage Youth to stay in the program.</p> <p>The Crew will host a Join Scouting Activity between September 1, 2020 and November 15, 2020</p> <p>A Crew will add a minimum of 1 new Venturer from 2019 re-charter.</p> <p><u>Year-round for all units:</u></p> <p>Host at least one “Bring a Buddy” event inviting non-members to participate in a Scouting activity.</p> <p>New Units: New units will need to show growth from their initial charter registration.</p>	
<p>5</p>	<p>Summer Camp Experience –Troops will have 60% of their Scouts (membership as of 4/1/20) attend a summer program at Griswold Scout Reservation. Packs will have 50% of their Cubs/Webelos attend a resident camp session at Camp Carpenter and/or a Council operated Cub Scout Day Camp. Crews will have 30% of their Scouts attend a summer program at Griswold Scout Reservation. Attendance at DWC’s NYLT, a High Adventure Base as an alternative or staffing a DWC camp, provisional campers and Den Chief’s attending a DWC camp can be included in a unit’s camp numbers.</p>	
<p>6</p>	<p>Quality Leadership: The primary unit leader and at least 60% of the units registered youth facing volunteers will have completed and maintained the training required for their position and 100% of the unit leadership is Youth Protection Trained at the time of re-charter.</p>	
<p>7</p>	<p>Re-Charter: The unit will re-charter and submit all paperwork and fees on the designated date set by the Council/District.</p>
