

HISTORIC DISTRICT UNIT SERVICE AWARD

This award is intended to recognize individuals, couples, civic organizations or businesses who've made a significant contribution to a BSA Troop, Pack, Crew, Team or, Ship in the Historic District, by their leadership, mentorship, volunteerism or, by their sacrifice of time or treasure. Recipient(s) **do not** have to be registered members of the BSA.

The award will be presented at the Annual Recognition & Fellowship Event scheduled for Saturday, March 7, 2020 the Raymond High School Cafeteria at 6PM.

Eligibility & Nominating Process:

Maximum of one award per unit, per year

Minimum service period to qualify for the recognition shall be one calendar year

Maximum of one award shall be made in a recipient's lifetime

Nomination forms must be signed by the unit leader (only), without the nominees' knowledge.

Unit leaders, while serving, are ineligible. There are National BSA awards available to unit leaders, such as; Scouter's Key, Training Awards or Unit Leader Award of Merit

Nomination forms must be submitted to Senior District Executive, Skip Chase (skip.chase@scouting.org) no later than Friday, February 28, 2020.

Processing:

The Historic District Committee will screen nominations to ensure they meet the award criteria but, *will not approve or disapprove them based on merit...*that's the responsibility of the unit.

If the District Committee rejects a nomination for any reason, the unit leader will be informed. He or she may submit another nomination in its place.
