

Use of Council Properties During COVID-19  
(Effective June 23, 2020)

**Closed Council Properties:**

The following properties shall remain closed to all use during COVID-19 due the lack of proper facilities that would allow for proper hygiene to be maintained during use.

- Unity

**Open properties for Unit use:**

**Acceptable Use:** Acceptable use of the property is defined as hiking, biking, fishing, unit meetings that may cover skill instruction, orienteering, outside court of Honor, Board of Reviews, or den activities that can be held outside. Unit camping is not permitted on any Council owned property. All units/districts/council must adhere to either Camp Carpenter or Griswold Scout Reservations rules in addition to those listed here.

**Latrine Use:** Units & others will be assigned a campsite in which they must only use that latrine. This is necessary so proper sanitation and disinfecting can occur after each use and reduces the cost to operate the property.

**Camp Carpenter**

- All buildings, except for the Scout Shop (Operated by National BSA), the Museum and Nuttle Lodge shall remain closed.
- All program areas shall remain closed
- Use of outside areas will be permitted to be used by units, this includes the outside deck of the Camp Carpenter Dining Hall and the pavilion located at Silber
- A signed Unit Activity Agreement must be on file at the Council office prior to use
- All units must adhere to the latest Unit Activity Guidance as published by the Daniel Webster Council in conjunction with the State of NH.
- All units wishing to use the property must reserve a space in advance by contacting Steve Hambleton at [StephenP.Hambleton@scouting.org](mailto:StephenP.Hambleton@scouting.org)
- Units granted permission on a weekend must remain away from any campsites that are being used for Family Camping.

**Griswold Scout Reservation**

- All buildings and program areas shall remain closed.
- Use of outside areas will be permitted to be used by units, this includes the pavilion located at Camp Bell
- A signed Unit Activity Agreement must be on file at the Council office prior to use
- All units must adhere to the latest Unit Activity Guidance as published by the Daniel Webster Council in conjunction with the State of NH.

- Units granted permission on a weekend must remain away from any campsites that are being used for Family Camping.

## **Hoge & Whip-o- Will**

- All buildings and program areas shall remain closed, if applicable.
- Use of outside areas will be permitted to be used by units.
- Any unit wishing to use these properties is aware that there is no running water and that they must ensure proper provisions are made for sanitization.
- A signed Unit Activity Agreement must be on file at the Council office prior to use
- All units must adhere to the latest Unit Activity Guidance as published by the Daniel Webster Council in conjunction with the State of NH.
