YOUTH PROTECTION TRAINING POLICY



The Boy Scouts of America requires mandatory Youth Protection training for all registered volunteers. In Daniel Webster Council, new leaders are required to take Youth Protection training before being registered with the Boy Scouts of America. <u>Youth Protection Training must be taken annually in the Daniel Webster Council.</u> If a volunteer's Youth Protection training record is not current for **the entirety of charter year**, the volunteer will not be re-registered.

To ensure these policies are fully implemented, please take the following steps before beginning the rechartering process:

- Review the YPT "Y or N" indicator for each adult leader listed on the Charter Renewal Roster.
- If a unit leader's Youth Protection training will expire before the end of charter, they will need to complete the training on My.Scouting.org. The volunteer will need to make sure that their membership ID number is listed on their person profile. The number can be found on their Boy Scouts of America membership card, and on the Unit Roster.
- If the volunteer has completed Youth Protection training online but did not use their DWC membership ID number, they should log back on to My.Scouting.org and input their membership ID number so the training will be linked with their BSA records.
- Any training taken online or updates made to the council's database after the roster has been submitted in Internet Rechartering it will not be reflected in the Internet Rechartering process.
 A copy of the Youth Protection training certificate needs to be provided with the completed recharter paperwork.

Units should also check with their chartered partner to determine if there are additional registration requirements for your unit. Chartering organizations that have their own internal volunteer training must complete both, the organization and the BSA's youth protection program, in order to be registered. Catholic sponsored unites require "Not On My Watch" training, which can be completed online at https://nhchildsafety.org. A registration code is needed prior to taking this training.
