

Policy Regarding Fundraising for Eagle Projects in Daniel Webster Council

- Scouts who wish to fundraise for their Eagle project must adhere to the rules and guidelines specified in the “Procedures and Limitations on Eagle Scout Service Project Fundraising” found in the *Eagle Service Project Workbook*.
- While Scouts may serve as solicitors for materials and services for their project, Scouts may not solicit for money. This is to be consistent with the *CHARTER AND BYLAWS OF THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA* (May 2021, page 17), which states: “Youth members shall not be permitted to serve as solicitors of money for chartered organizations, for the local council, for the National Council, for corporate sponsors, or in support of other organizations”. Therefore, District Eagle Boards shall not approve Eagle projects that utilize systems, platforms, or activities, electronic or otherwise, that are to be used for the purposes of soliciting money.
