What is this ticket I hear about?

The Wood Badge “Ticket” represents your commitment to complete a set of personal goals relating to your Scouting position. Upon completion of your “Ticket” you will be presented with the Wood Badge certificate, neckerchief, woggle and beads at an appropriate public ceremony.

What is the course registration fee?

- Full course fee is \$295.00, but there are discounts available to you to reduce the cost to \$245.00
- If you register and pay your deposit before March 15, 2022 you receive a \$25.00 if you
