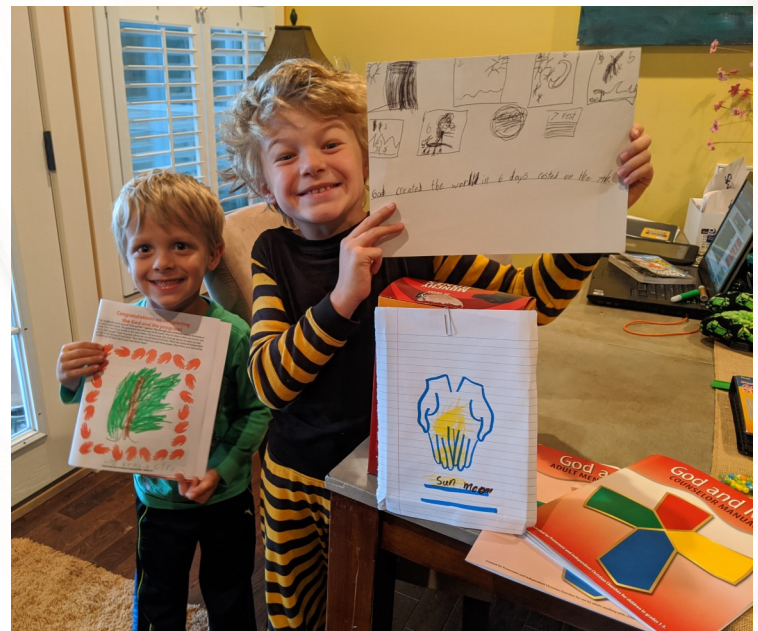
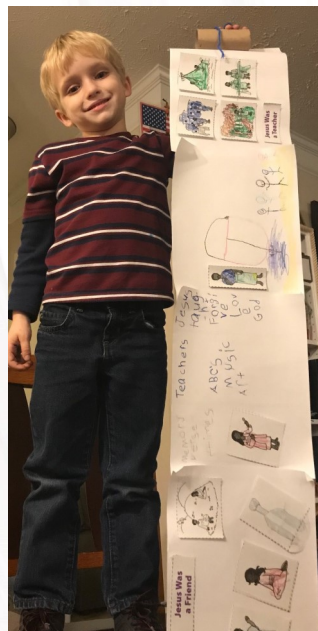

### Prerequisites:

- ⇒ Students must be in Kindergarten or 1st Grade
- ⇒ Parents must attend all online sessions.
- ⇒ Families must purchase a Student Workbook for each child. Plan ahead and order in time for our first meeting on [www.praypub.org](http://www.praypub.org).
- ⇒ Students must answer all questions, complete the activity, and complete service projects at home.
- ⇒ Families will be responsible for submitting the youth registration upon completion of the program and purchasing recognitions via the P.R.A.Y. online store.

### Class Schedule: 3pm-3:50pm (central) on Sundays

- ⇒ Session 1: Jesus Was a Storyteller (October 16th)
- ⇒ Session 2: Jesus was a Teacher (October 23rd)
- ⇒ Session 3: Jesus Was a Friend (October 30th)
- ⇒ Session 4: Jesus Was a Healer (November 6th)
- ⇒ Session 5: Wrap Up & Review (November 13th)



Please note: The P.R.A.Y. awards are used by Protestant and Independent Christian Churches. These classes will not shortcut the program but will provide instruction and opportunity for interaction to help each child fulfill the requirements and grow stronger in their Christian faith on a virtual platform.

# Frequently Asked Questions

**How do you register for the class?** Go to the [registration page](#) and get a ticket for each student participating. There is no cost to sign up for the class. Just the cost of the materials you order directly from P.R.A.Y. Pub.

**How do you order the class materials?** Go to the link on the front of the flyer. There you should at minimum order the Student Workbook for the class. If a parent is going to be involved, order a Mentor Workbook as well. At the end of the program, you will go back to this website and order whichever recognition items you want to present your child with at that time. There will be an attestation box that you have completed the Pastor review on the website. This is done during the November 13th class.

**Do you have to be in the Boy Scouts of America, Girl Scouts of the United States of America, or American Heritage Girls to attend the class or earn the medal?** Not at all. P.R.A.Y. programs are open to anyone at that age level. You can be registered in a different youth development program, or no program at all. So invite your siblings and neighbors.

**What type of adult leadership is involved?** We also ask that each family has one parent present during each class session. That way you can help your participant during sessions, and participate as a family on projects between sessions. Our Counselor will lead each class session.

**Can our family participate together?** We encourage it! Be active with your student.

**Are there programs for other ages being offered?** There are other sessions happening for each of the five program levels with P.R.A.Y. Pub. Jesus & Me (K-1), God & Me (2-3), God & Family (4-6), God & Church (6-8), God & Life (9-12). The Registration Site lists all the classes.

**How are we recognizing the Participants?** Participants are encouraged to be recognized at their home church on Scout Sunday or other appropriate ceremony location.

## Session Descriptions

### **Session 1: Jesus Was a Storyteller (October 16th 3pm-3:50pm central)**

Children will learn what it means to be a storyteller, learn that Jesus was the Son of God, identify people in their lives who are storytellers, and learn to be a storyteller themselves.

“And Jesus told them many things in parables.” - Matthew 13:3

### **Session 2: Jesus was a Teacher (October 23rd 3pm-3:50pm central)**

Children will learn the characteristics of a teacher, learn to see Jesus as their teacher, identify people in their lives who are teachers, and learn to be teachers themselves.

“Then Jesus went about among the villages teaching.” - Mark 6:6

### **Session 3: Jesus Was a Friend (October 30th 3pm-3:50pm central)**

Children will learn what it means to be a friend, learn to see Jesus as a friend, name people in their lives who are friends, and learn what it means to be a good friend.

“I have called you friends.” - John 15:15

### **Session 4: Jesus Was a Healer (November 6th 3pm-3:50pm central)**

Children will learn the characteristics of a healer, identify Jesus as a healer, name people in their lives who are healers, and learn how to be a healer themselves.

“Jesus cured all who were sick.” - Matthew 8:16

### **Session 5: Wrap Up & Review (November 13th 3pm-3:50pm central)**

Children will review the four lessons and finalize the program.
