

Life Scouts on the Trail to Eagle. Your Unit Scouters are to encourage and help you earn the Eagle Rank.

Do you have an Eagle Coach? If not, ask your Unit Leader or the Unit Committee Chair.

- An Eagle Coach will guide you on your journey.

Here are the <u>Requirements</u> for Eagle, please note the ones in bold.
1. Be active in your Troop for at least six months as a Life Scout.
2. As a Life Scout, demonstrate Scout Spirit by living the Scout Oath and Law.
(see handbook). Include people who've seen your Scout Spirit.
3. Earn 21 Merit Badges; 14 which are required. (See handbook)
4. Serve in a leadership role in the Troop for six months. (See handbook)
5. Plan, Develop and give leadership for your Eagle Project.
Develop this project with your coach and beneficiary.

Eagle Project Plan
Use the Eagle Workbook to type up your project plan. This is your project
proposal.
Complete the following in this order:
Have your beneficiary sign the project plan and fundraising application.
Meet the Scoutmaster to review your project and get his/her signature
Meet the Troop Committee Chair to review your project and get her/his
signature
Schedule your Massabesic Eagle Board to propose your plan for their
approval with Pastor Shupe

Notify your Scoutmaster and Eagle Coach of your Eagle Board time and date for them to attend with you. Complete your Eagle Project Plan and review with your Eagle Coach and SM. Once approved notify your Eagle Project Service Dates with SPL, SM and your Eagle Coach Keep track of everyone who works on your project (service hours) **Final Steps** Fill out your Eagle Application **Complete Certification By Applicant (below Requirement #6 on the Eagle** Application, which is a statement of your ambitions and life purpose and leadership positions (this is to be typed). **Complete your Eagle Workbook - Final project report** Have your Scoutmaster Conference and final SM signature Have your paperwork signed by Troop Committee Chair Through the Daniel Webster Council Website apply with your Eagle Application and statement of your ambitions and life purpose. Then you will be contacted for your Final Board of Review by Pastor Shupe. Questions? Ask your Scoutmaster or Eagle Coach.
