This is a Class A event. All scouts must be in full uniform. Packs are invited and encouraged to bring their Pack flags to the event. Food will be available for purchase.

Good sportsmanship a vital part of any competition and all spectators are asked to adhere to the principles of courtesy and sportsmanship during the races. We hope to start all races on time and will need all Cubs to be there no later than the start of their posted registration time. Once the racing begins a tardy scout will not be able to race with their rank. Please inform all Scouts and families the importance of this in advance of the race day.

A designated leader from each Pack must complete the registration online to ensure we have all Scouts from each Pack entered to race ahead of time for a seamless flow between heats on race day!

Cost is \$10 per scout – NO REFUNDS

Fill out the Registration Form to indicate information on each Scout that will enter the Derby so it can be inputted into the race software.

Trophies will be awarded to the top three finishers in each rank and also the top three overall finishers in THE GRAND FINALS race. Each Scout participating will receive a 2023 District Pinewood Derby patch to commemorate the event.

Each Pack may send the top THREE finishers in each Rank from their own Pack Derby. If any one of the top three from each rank cannot attend, the Pack may choose to send the next highest-ranking qualifiers. So, a grand total of EIGHTEEN Cubs from each Pack may be registered for the District race. The goal is to invite as many scouts as possible. If a pack does not have enough Scouts in a particular rank to fill all three slots, they may send additional scouts from other ranks in order to reach the 18 limit.

REGISTRATION AND RACE TIMES!!

Please note, not everyone needs to arrive right at 8 AM. See the race schedule below to know when your Scouts rank races and registers. The top three from each rank category will come back to race in the GRAND FINALS later in the day. Everyone is welcome to spend as much time walking the scenic grounds of the Strong Foundations campus between breaks and all are encouraged to help support the Pack 90 for hosting this year's derby by visiting their concession stand throughout the day.

Registration for the Lions/Tigers – 8 a.m. All qualifying Lions & Tigers should report to be weighed, adjusted, and ready for their race to begin at 9 a.m.

Registration for Wolves – 9:30 a.m. Their race will start when the Lion/Tiger race is over, approximately 10:30 a.m.

Registration for Bears – 11 p.m. Their race will start when the Wolf race is over, approximately 12 a.m.

Registration for Webelos and AOL's – 12 p.m. Their race will start when the Bear race is over.

At registration each car will be inspected to make sure it adheres to the WANNALANCIT DISTRICT DERBY RULES. Likely if you are using the same car you won at your Pack derby, it will. All adjustments must be made in the PIT AREA prior to registration. Once your car is registered it will be placed onto the staging table where it will remain until the race begins and it heads to the track.

THE grand finals – The top three from EACH RACE will be called back to compete for the TOP THREE IN THE WANNALANCIT DISTRICT when the Webelos/AOL race is over. All qualifiers must report back no later than 1:30 p.m. for the GRAND FINALS race.
