



2026 Scout Cards Fundraiser

OVERVIEW

Scout cards are an excellent way for units and scouts to help fund their scouting activities, such as summer camps. This fundraiser was structured to maximize the unit's profit. In 2026, the fundraiser was changed in several exciting ways to improve the unit's ability to be successful. We've outlined the details below. Scout Cards are available starting February 9th, while supplies last. It is important to note that we only have 10,000 Scout Cards available for the entire state, and we will not be able to place additional orders. Please plan accordingly and make sure that your unit doesn't miss out.

HOW THE SCOUT CARDS FUNDRAISER WORKS

Scout Cards have a suggested value of \$10.00 with the flexibility for units to sell at a higher or lower value, at the unit's discretion. Scout Cards have a per-card cost of \$3.00, so that is a \$7.00 profit direct to the unit if the cards are sold at the suggested price. Individual families should only sell cards using the sale price set by the unit. Only the Unit

Scout Card Coordinator and or unit leader should determine whether the selling price should differ.

The Scout Card has been redesigned to highlight Scouts from New Hampshire, and it includes a lot of great local offers, with an exciting new feature at no cost- a nationwide savings code on each card! Just enter the savings code on the website on the card to obtain discounts and offers from over 500,000 companies nationwide. The 2026 Scout Card is now easier than ever to sell!

The unique online code will enable people to redeem up to 10 physical savings that can be printed and redeemed at their local location and unlimited online discount redemptions within the card's expiration date of 12/31/2026.

2026 Scout Cards are NON-REFUNDABLE. Units should plan accordingly for the number of cards they are ordering.

HOW TO ORDER SCOUT CARDS

Orders must be completed by the unit. Individual families need to coordinate with their unit to order Scout Cards.

The cards are bundled and sold in packs of 10. Units are required to pay for the cards at pickup or delivery. Units are only required to pay the \$3.00 card fee per card.

For example, if a unit orders four packs of cards (40 cards @ \$3.00 per) they will owe \$120.00 at the time of pickup/delivery. Scout Cards can be paid for with the following methods of payment.

- Cash
- Check
- Credit / Debit Cards (a 3% processing fee will be applied)

For credit and debit card payments, a 3% processing fee will be added to the total amount owed for the cards, increasing the per-card cost to \$3.09. A unit that orders four packs (40 cards) would owe \$123.60 if paid with a credit or debit card. This processing fee is what the council is charged for accepting credit card payments.
